A: Essential Conditions:

- 1. The following Establishments/Organizations are eligible to establish nursing Colleges in J & K
 - i) Central/State Government/Local body
 - ii) Registered Private or Public Trust
 - iii) Organizations registered under societies registration Act including Missionary Organizations
 - iv) Companies incorporated under Section 8 of Company's Act.
- 2. The eligible Organizations/Establishments should obtain Essentiality/ No objection certificate from the State Government.
- 3. After receipt of the Essentiality Certificate /No objection Certificate, the eligible institutions shall get recognition from the concerned State Nursing Council.
- 4. Nursing Educational Institution should be in Institutional area only and not in residential area.
- 5. If the Institute is also offering Non-Nursing programme, in that case, the nursing programme should have separate teaching block.
- 6. Separate teaching block shall be available if it is in hospital premises.
- 7. Proportionately the size of the built-up area will increase according to the number of students admitted.
- 8. Affiliation of Psychiatric Hospital should be for a minimum of 50 beds.
- 9. The nursing staffing norms in the affiliated hospital should be as per the Indian Nursing Council (INC) norms.
- 10. The eligible Organisations/ Establishments shall have their own 100 bedded Parent Hospital. Provided that in respect of Tribal and Hilly Area, the requirement of own Parent Hospital is exempted. The hilly areas also include UT of Jammu and Kashmir

- 11. College of Nursing shall have 100 bedded parent/ own Hospital. A parent hospital would be a hospital either owned and controlled by the Trust/Society/Company or managed and controlled by a trustee/member/director of the trust/society/company.
- 12. Maximum of 100 seats shall be sanctioned for B. Sc Nursing Program subject to the condition that the applicant college has parent medical college or parent hospital having 300 beds or above. The applicant college which does not have parent medical college or having less than 300 bedded parent hospital, shall be sanctioned a maximum of 60 seats.
- 13. In Hilly areas, a college can be sanctioned 100 seats subject to the condition that the applicant college has a tie-up with a hospital having 300 beds or above.
- 14. The distance between two Nursing Colleges shall be more than 10 Kilometers.
